ACTION ALERT – Urge your senators to fight for more LGA funding!

The Minnesota Senate tax bill, unveiled this morning, contains a \$12 million one-time, one-year increase for Local Government Aid in 2018. This is far less than the \$45.5 million increase needed to get LGA back to its 2002 funding level. Greater Minnesota senators need to know that the LGA funding in their tax bill is inadequate!

As a Greater Minnesota city leader, it is important that you contact your senator and urge him or her to push for more LGA funding this session.

Tell your senator that:

- 1) You and other members of your community want the Legislature to pass a \$45.5 million LGA increase this session.
- 2) With a \$1.65 billion state budget surplus and a \$900 million Senate tax bill, a \$45.5 million LGA increase is reasonable and achievable.
- 3) You are counting on your senator to support this goal and fight for an LGA increase all the way through the end of the legislative session.
